HIGH SCHOOL & POST-SECONDARY SCHOLARSHIP INSTRUCTIONS

NW Plus CU (**nw**+|cu) will award scholarships for the 2021-2022 academic year; these will be awarded to graduating high school seniors and post-secondary students.

NOTICE: Applicants 18 years and older must be a member in good standing 60 days upon application for a scholarship. For applicants under 18 years of age, they or their parents must be a member in good standing for 60 days upon application for the scholarship. Funds awarded through this scholarship program may be used for Tuition & Qualified Expenses only. Family members of **nw**+|cu employees and volunteer officials are ineligible.

APPLICATION PACKET

The following items must be submitted: *Please no staples or bound material*

- 1. The **nw**+|cu Scholarship Application Form.
- 2. Two letters of recommendation. The letters should include the author's relationship to you and how long they have known you.
- 3. a. High School Transcripts and SAT scores, if recent (within 5 years) high school graduate.
 - b. College Transcripts, if post-secondary student currently or within last 5 years.
 - c. If neither, please explain your circumstances with a detailed letter.
- 4. The following attachments:
 - ✓ Description of community service and/or school activities
 - ✓ Essay on educational goals and interests

APPLICATION DEADLINE

The complete application packet must be postmarked on or before March 12, 2021. The Selection Committee will make its decision by May 10, 2021. The completed application should be mailed to:
