NOTICE: Applicants 18 years and older must be a member in good standing 60 days upon application for a scholarship. For applicants under 18 years of age, they or their parents must be a member in good standing for 60 days upon application for the scholarship. Funds awarded through this scholarship program may be used for Tuition & Qualified Expenses only.

No family member of a **nw+**|cu employee or volunteer official is eligible.

Application Packet

The following items must be submitted: Please, no staples or bound material

- 1. The **nw+**|cu Scholarship Application Form.
- 2. Two letters of recommendation. The letters should include the author's relationship to applicant and how long they have known applicant.
- 3. High School Transcripts and SAT scores, if recent (within 5 years) high school graduate.
 - College Transcripts, if applicant is currently a post-secondary student or has been within last years.
 - If neither, please explain your circumstances with a detailed letter.
- 4. The following attachments:
 - ✓ Description of community service and/or school activities
 - ✓Essay on educational goals and interests

Application Deadline

The complete application packet must be postmarked on or before March 15, 2023. The Selection Committee will make its decision by May 9, 2023. The completed application should be mailed to:
