- Each bidder will be notified of the highest bid and each bidder will be given the opportunity to place a higher bid in increments of **\$100.00** or more. If the bidder does not wish to increase his/her bid the bidder may withdraw from the bidding process at this time. Once a bidder has withdrawn, no further bids will be accepted from that bidder on this property. If NW Plus Credit Union fails to reach a bidder after one attempt, that bidder will be dropped from the bid process and the original bid will be considered the highest bid.
- The bidding cycle will continue until all bidders but one have dropped from the bidding process. The fact that a bidder has the highest bid DOES NOT guarantee that the vehicle will be sold for that amount.
